
The Department of Health has confirmed the 'Boil Water' Notice issued by Brandon Walraven for Little River RDA, Foreman Waterworks, and Winthrop Waterworks. This order was issued as a precautionary measure because of the possibility that contaminated water may enter the distribution system as a result of repairs to the water treatment plant.

Under the 'Boil Water' Notice, all affected customers are advised that the water may be unsafe for human consumption, and water used for drinking or food preparation must be boiled briskly for one (1) minute prior to use. All ice cubes should be discarded and only boiled water used for making ice.

This Notice will be in effect by the Department of Health until further notice.

We recommend that you directly notify the news media.

THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH HAS CONFIRMED A 'BOIL WATER' NOTICE ISSUED BY BRANDON WALRAVEN FOR THE LITTLE RIVER RDA, FOREMAN WATERWORKS, AND WINTHROP WATERWORKS. THIS ORDER WAS ISSUED AS A PRECAUTIONARY MEASURE BECAUSE OF THE POSSIBILITY THAT CONTAMINATED WATER MAY ENTER THE DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM AS A RESULT OF TEMPORARY REPAIRS TO THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT.

UNDER THE 'BOIL WATER' ORDER, ALL AFFECTED CUSTOMERS MUST BE ADVISED THAT THE WATER MAY BE UNSAFE FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION, AND WATER USED FOR DRINKING OR FOOD PREPARATION MUST BE BOILED BRISKLY FOR ONE (1) MINUTE PRIOR TO USE. ALL ICE CUBES SHOULD BE DISCARDED AND ONLY BOILED WATER USED FOR MAKING ICE.

THIS "PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE" WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.
